TASKS AND GUIDELINES

What we make available to you

- One room, shared use of kitchen and bathroom
- Washing machine and dryer for free use
- Bed linen and towels
- Occasional team lunches or Shabbat Dinners are provided by Ebenezer: other food is not included. You are responsible for buying and making your own food.

Working hours / Free time

- A working day includes 6-8 hours / 5 days a week. The working hours can be kept flexible according to the circumstances in the house. Additional availability might be requested.
- Days off can be accumulated for longer term volunteers, and additional days off can be requested.

Responsibilities

- Prepare rooms for new olim arriving
- Check-in / Check-out
- Help with the olim moving in and out
- Be the contact person for questions and concerns of olim
- Keeping the house clean
- Laundry / Gardening / Shopping
- Help prepare and host events in the house (feasts, tea time, Shabbat,..)
- Willingness to help with all work, even light renovations in the house

Please make sure to

- Get informed about the ministry of Ebenezer and about the subject of Aliyah
- Bring work clothes that can get dirty and that are modest
- Tell us if you are planning to spend some of the time here in Israel traveling, so that we know that during this time you are not working with us
- Talk with us if you brought gifts or booklets, etc. to bless the olim, before you give it to them. Serving the olim is a sensitive matter, and we want to make sure that what we make available to them is fitting and according to the guidelines of the ministry. We do not evangelize here in the house.

VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT

1. I confirm I have read, understood and agree with all the guidelines set and will comply with them.
2. I acknowledge that I give my time, service and skills to Ebenezer free of charge and that I am not employed by Ebenezer.
3. During my service with Ebenezer, I agree to put the vision and guidelines of Ebenezer ahead of my own vision.

6. I agree that I will maintain, at my own expense, whilst working with Ebenezer all necessary and usual insurances (health, ...).
7. Having completed the medical section on this form, I agree to notify the Ebenezer staff prior to my arrival of any changes to my health which may need to be taken into consideration during my volunteer service.
8. I declare that information I have provided is correct and complete to the best of my knowledge. I agree that Ebenezer will hold my information and share it with relevant team members in relation to my placement. I understand that at any time after completion of my volunteer service, I may request my data be removed from all records.
